Frequently Asked Questions by Tennessee Transfer Pathways (TTP) Majors

- 1. *Will I transfer to a 4-year institution as a junior?* Yes, as long as you transfer to a Tennessee public or private college/university. See question #6 below.
- 2. Are all of my credits guaranteed to transfer? Yes, as long as you transfer to a Tennessee public or private college/university. See question #6 below.
- 3. What is the difference between a Tennessee Transfer Pathway (TTP) and University Parallel? For TTP majors, the student is guaranteed that all NSCC courses taken will be accepted at the college/university and the courses will count toward completion of his/her major. For University Parallel majors, the courses taken at NSCC are most likely to transfer, but are not guaranteed. It is always best for the student to contact the selected transfer college or university as early as possible.
- 4. What are the career opportunities for my major? Academic advisors have access to an advisement toolbox that contains information pertaining to career outcomes for all TTP majors.
- 5. *How do I access additional career information for my major?* Academic advisors have access to an advisement toolbox that contains *additional* career information for all TTP majors.
- 6. Upon transfer, how does the Tennessee Transfer Pathway work? A student who completes all the courses listed on a particular Transfer Pathway will earn an A.A. or A.S. degree at the community college. When the student transfers to a Tennessee public or private college/university, the transcript will certify that the pathway has been followed. The student is guaranteed that all the community college courses taken will be accepted at the college/university and the courses will count toward completion of the particular major.

If a community college student transfers to another Tennessee community college, he or she is guaranteed that all courses transfer.
