

## LEARNING SUPPORT ADVISING – Overview

Per a system-wide change in all TBR schools, Learning Support will no longer be offered in a pre-requisite format. The only exception is for students whose applied or technical program does not require college-level reading, writing/English, and/or math (see p. 18 of this handbook for a list of these programs). All other students who test into Learning Support will take a Learning Support class numbered 0815, 0825, 0835, or 0845 along with the designated co-requisite college-level class.

Please refer to documentation that follows for specific information about co-requisite Learning Support. It will help you as you go through these steps.

**Step One** – Use myNSCC to determine a student's test scores.

**Step Two** – If a student's ACT scores are close to qualifying him/her to take college-level courses with no Learning Support, suggest that s/he take the COMPASS test again. Direct student to the Testing Center, specifying that students cannot take the COMPASS test more than two times.

**Step Three** – Enroll student in co-requisite Learning Support courses as necessary.

- a) The student must enroll in a section of 0815, 0825, 0835, or 0845 and the co-requisite college-level class **at the same time**. Banner is not programmed for a student to enroll in one of these numbered courses and then the college-level class because of the co-requisite feature.
- b) Keeping in mind the TBR suggestion that literacy be remediated first, we will need to advise students with the following pathways in mind for students who are Level 1 in both reading and writing/English, that is, who need Learning Support for both:
  - **If a student can take only six hours**, s/he will need to enroll in READ 0815 and one of the following: ART 1030, ARTH 2010, ARTH 2020, MUS 1030, or THEA 1030.
  - **If a student can take only nine hours**, s/he will need to enroll in READ 0815, ENGL 0815, and ENGL 1010.
  - **If a student can take twelve hours**, s/he may enroll in READ 0815, ENGL 0815, ENGL 1010 and one of the following: ART 1030, ARTH 2010, ARTH 2020, HIST 2000, HIST 2010, HIST 2020, HIST 2030, MUS 1030, PSYC 1030, PSCY 2000, PSCY 2110, PSYC 2130, SOCI 1010, or THEA 1030.
- c) If a student needs only reading or English/writing, **and** needs math, enrolling in a co-requisite pair of math classes is advisable. The student would need to be able to enroll in 13 hours.
