Student Advising Questions

- Do you understand the requirements and purpose of learning support classes? (if the student needs the learning support courses)
- Do you plan to transfer to university?
 - Before or after getting an associate's degree?
 - The AS/AA degrees will transfer to TBR universities and meet all of their gen ed requirements, but without the degree, classes will transfer class by class.
 - o Do you understand Tennessee Pathways requirements?
 - Are you aware of the importance of looking at specific requirements for schools outside of TBR system: UT system/private universities?
 - o Do You know where to find the requirements for my major and degree?
- Do you understand the difference between an AAS and an AS/AA degree?
- Do you understand that it is your responsibility to have a textbook (for those classes that require one) by the first day of class or ASAP?
- Scheduling questions: Morning? Evening? Days? Part-time? Full-time?
- Are you considering your work schedule and other time obligations in scheduling your classes?
- Am I including time for reading/studying outside of class?
- Do you know that TR classes meet on both Tuesdays and Thursdays?
- Do you know how to read the catalog and the printed schedule?
- Do you know about the Information Technology website's list of classes (ww2.nscc.edu/it)?
- Do you understand the meaning of course section numbers? (Some students sign up for off-campus classes without realizing where the class meets.)
- Do you know that it is important that you attend all of your classes from the *first day* and that to be on time?
- Are you aware of challenge test options for Learning Support Reading and Writing?
- Do you really know what is required of a student taking an online class?
