

PRE-REQUISITE COURSE REQUIREMENTS AND ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

1. Student in good standing at Nashville State Community College.
2. Application to NSCC Nursing program with **copy** of college transcripts attached.
3. Grade of "C" or better in pre-requisite courses listed below.

Math and Science Course Completion

BIOL 2010	Anatomy and Physiology I	4 credit hours
BIOL 2020	Anatomy and Physiology II	4 credit hours
BIOL 2230	Microbiology	4 credit hours
MATH 1530	Probability and Statistics	3 credit hours

General Education Course Completion

The NSCC Nursing Program requires students to complete 4 General Education courses.

Required general education courses include:

ENGL 1010	English Composition	3 credit hours
PSYC 1030	Introduction to Psychology	3 credit hours
Humanities Elective	(see catalogue)	3 credit hours

Must take one of the general education courses listed below:

ENGL 1020	English Composition II	3 credit hours
PSYC 2130	Lifespan Psychology	3 credit hours
SPCH 1010	Fundamentals of Speech Communication	3 credit hours
BIOL 1215	Principles of Nutrition	3 credit hours

4. GPA of 2.8 or better (excluding developmental) on pre-requisite courses.
5. Math and Science prerequisites completed spring before fall admission.
6. Recommended completion of required General Education courses spring before fall admission.
7. Completion of **ATI-Test of Essential Academic Skills (ATI-TEAS)** within prescribed time frame with "Basic" as the minimum level of proficiency.

The levels of ATI-TEAS academic preparedness accepted by NSCC include:

Basic
Proficient
Advanced
Exemplary

8. All ESL coursework as recommended by the Michigan test must be completed. Courses may not be waived.
