Application and Admission Requirements

- Student in good standing at Nashville State Community College
- Completed application to NSCC Nursing program with copy of college transcripts
- Grade of “C” or better in all pre-requisite courses
- GPA of 2.8 or better (excluding developmental) in pre-requisite courses
- Completion of ATI-TEAS at “Basic” Level
- ESL students must complete courses recommended by Michigan test (no waivers allowed)

(Preference will be given to those students who have successfully completed the Math and Science courses)

Pre-requisite Course Requirements

Math and Science Prerequisites *(Must be completed spring semester)*

- BIOL 2010 A & P I
- BIOL 2020 A & P II
- BIOL 2230 Microbiology
- Math 1530 Probability/Statistics

(Recommend science courses be completed within 5 years before anticipated admission date)

15 credit hours

Required General Education Courses

- ENGL 1010
- PSYC 1030
- Humanities Elective

(Recommend completing general education courses prior to beginning nursing coursework)

9 credit hours

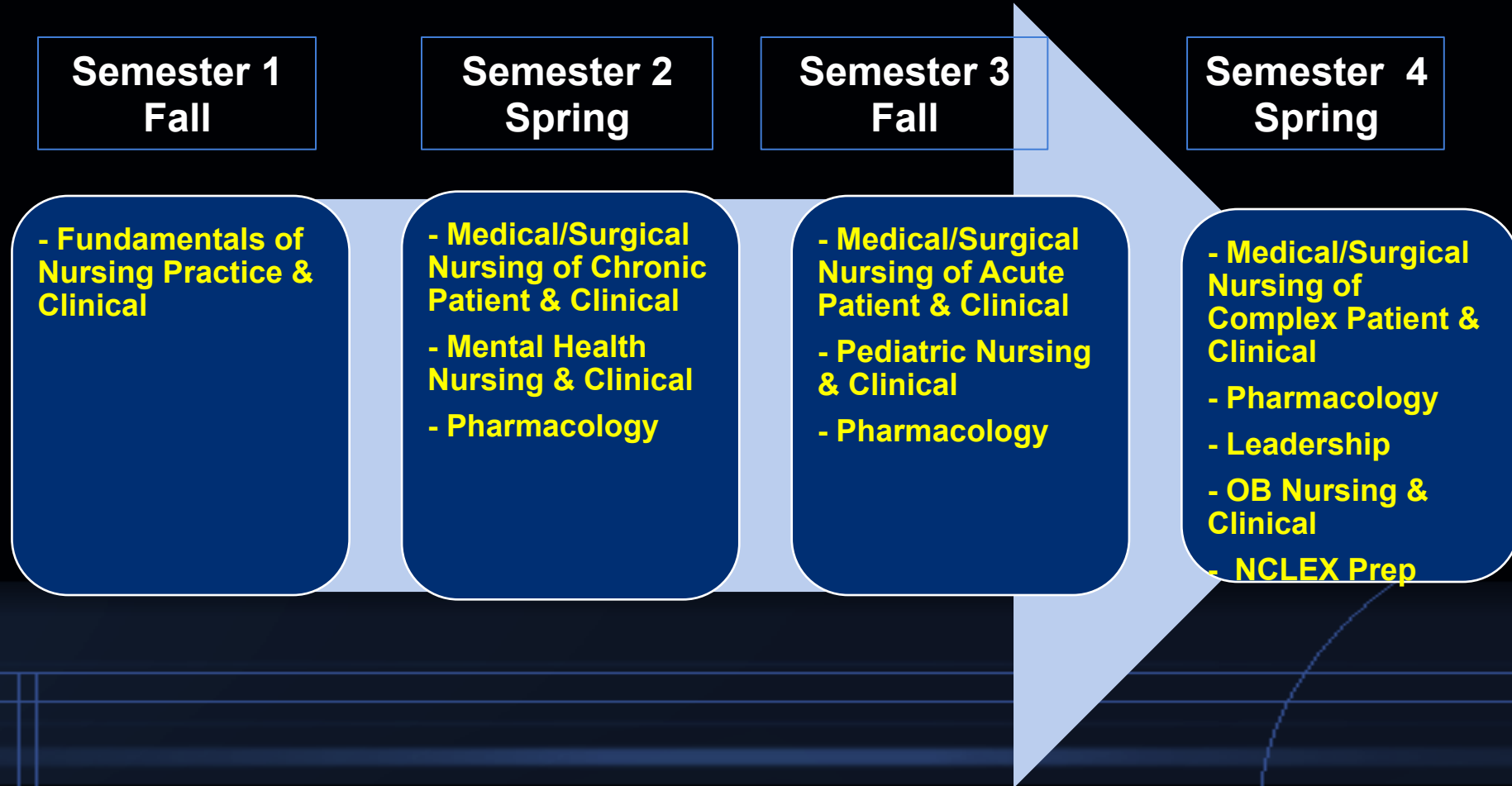

ATI-TEAS NURSING ENTRANCE EXAM

- *4 sections*
 - Reading
 - Math
 - Science
 - English
- *4 levels of proficiency reflect academic preparedness*
 - Basic = require additional preparation
 - Proficient = may require additional preparation
 - Advanced = unlikely to require additional preparation
 - Exemplary = additional preparation unlikely
- Registration via NSCC nursing website
- Test dates September 18, 2017 – February 22, 2018
- Seating limited
- Results available 48 hours after test completion
- May repeat x1 within 45 days

Selection Procedure for Admission

| ➤ Performance on nursing admission test | 20 points |
| • Basic | 5 points |
| • Proficient | 10 points |
| • Advanced | 15 points |
| • Exemplary | 20 points |
| ➤ Interview | 40 points |

Application Checklist

- GPA of 2.8 or better
- Minimum of C in college coursework
- NSCC College application with *official* transcripts
- NSCC Nursing application with *copy* of all college transcripts
- Math and Science prerequisites completed spring 2018
- Send *completed* application to Nursing Department in W-71
- Interviews scheduled based on:
 - Performance on admission test
(must achieve BASIC level of competency to be considered)
 - GPA
 - Completeness of application
