

Students graduating from the Nashville State Occupational Therapy Assistant Program are eligible to sit for the National Board for Certification Occupational in Occupational Therapy Certification Exam. Proof of successful completion of this exam is required for a license to practice as an Occupational Therapy Assistant in the state of Tennessee.

Scores below are calculated by graduating class. Example: “2013” denotes students who graduated in 2013.

NBCOT provides score information for all OT and OTA educational programs. Those scores are listed by school and calculated results are based upon students’ completion of the exam within a given calendar year (regardless of the graduation year).
