

Dear Prospective International Student:

Nashville State Community College (NSCC) is a two-year college offering Associate of Applied Science, Associate of Science and Associate of Arts degrees. Nashville State Community College also offers classes in English as a Second Language (ESL). Requirements for admission to Nashville State Community College and to receive an I-20 are also attached.

THE APPLICATION PROCESS SHOULD BE COMPLETED AND ALL DOCUMENTS RECEIVED AT LEAST ONE MONTH BEFORE THE OFFICIAL REGISTRATION DAY FOR THE SEMESTER TO ENTER.

These dates are as listed below:

Spring Semester 2016 – all documents must be in the Office of Admissions by December 9, 2015.

Fall Semester 2016- all documents must be in the Office of Admissions by July 8, 2016.

NSCC's tuition and fees at this time are \$7,636.50 per semester. In addition to the \$7,636.50 per semester, required medical insurance is currently \$864 per year. (See below)(Both are subject to increase). Each July our governing board increases the amount of fees and tuition. This does not include the cost of textbooks and supplies. It will cost approximately \$31,000 per year (an additional amount is required for dependents) to attend NSCC (includes estimated cost of living). In case of an emergency, you should have other means to handle any emergency, should one arise. We have no financial aid for international students. **YOU MUST ATTEND SCHOOL AS A FULL TIME STUDENT AND WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO WORK.**

You will be **required** to buy and enroll in the Student Accident and Sickness Insurance Plan 3 through the State University and Community College System of Tennessee. At this time the cost for one year of this coverage is \$864 per year (amount subject to change) for a student with no dependents. There is an extra cost for dependents.

A tuberculosis skin test showing freedom from that disease is required. It must be submitted within 15 days of the beginning of your first semester.

Also, a doctor's statement that all entering students born after 1957, must furnish documented proof of having immunity or having been immunized with two doses of Measles, Mumps, & Rubella (MMR) vaccine and if born after 1980, must furnish documented proof of having immunity or having been immunized with two doses of the Varicella or "chickenpox" vaccine, unless contraindicated because of pregnancy, allergy to a vaccine component, or other valid medical reasons. A form to be completed and signed by your doctor or Health Department and additional information is included with this letter.

Please complete the Hepatitis B Immunization Form (HBV).

There are apartments in the NSCC area. This college has no housing for students, so you must make your own arrangements for living accommodations. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact our office at (615) 353-3215.
