

## Running a population selection vs. running a pending letter


The tables that follow compare running a population selection and a non-pending letter with running a pending letter.

Using a population selection and a non-pending letter assumes you have written a population selection using the Population Selection Definition Rules Form (GLRSLCT). If you are running a pending letter, you do NOT use a population selection. The pending letter could have been added manually or automatically by a Banner Communication Plan.

## **Banner processes**

This table shows you the differences in how you use the relevant Banner processes.

## **Banner mail forms**

This table shows you the differences between running a letter for a population selection and a pending letter as they pertain to the mail form(s). The mail forms refer to either the Mail Query Form (GUIMAIL) or the product-specific mail forms.

Examples of the product-specific mail forms include:

- Student Mail Form (SUAMAIL)
- Applicant Mail Form (RUAMAIL)
- Mail Form Finance (FUAMAIL)
- (Human Resources) Mail Form (PUAMAIL)
- Advancement General Mail Form (AUAMAIL)
